The **Fairfield Community Garden** is the result of a collaboration between the **Sustainable Living Coalition**, **LLC** and the **City of Fairfield** to create the city's first community garden. Launched in 2022, it is located at the west end of **O B Nelson Park**. The garden spans a 100' x 100' fenced area and features 40 raised plots, a tool shed, a native perimeter garden, metal trellises, and a communal tool library. Thanks to the generous contributions of local businesses and community leaders, over **\$20,000** was raised for the infrastructure.
